## **Shopping Tips & Tricks**

Follow these helpful tips when shopping for what to wear for your senior photo session.

- **Shop your closet first!** I know you want something new but you might have the perfect outfit hanging in your closet! What is your absolute favorite thing to wear? That could be the perfect thing for your senior session.
- Look for variety when shopping! You will need a casual outfit, a dressy outfit and maybe something fun in between so make sure you look for a variety of things that fall into those categories. Don't just get dresses or just get skirts...make sure your outfits are different as in a jeans outfit, a dress and maybe a romper.
- Look for complimentary colors! When shopping, be sure you are looking at colors that look good for your skin tone. If you are fair skin, don't choose all whites because they will wash you out.
- Mix up colors and patterns! Don't choose the same color for every item. Again variety is key. So if you have a solid lavendar dress, make sure your other items are not lavendar and maybe throw in a pattern so you don't have all solids.
- Shop for a dress or a dressy outfit! At least one of your outfits for your senior session should be dressy. And a pretty dress is perfect for a dressy option. Look for one that you feel good in and that makes you feel special.
- Also shop for casual looks! Again, I can't stress enough that variety is key. So
  while I highly recommend a dress, I also recommend something casual such as jeans
  and a top.
- Choose items that fit the type of location you envision for your session! If you
  are envisioning an urban, downtown type location then shop for clothing that fit that
  look. If you are envisioning a field, then look for a flowy dress or something casual
  that works with a field.
- **Don't forget accessories!** Earrings, necklaces, bracelets, hats, scarves and more can really finish an outfit. Accessories can be the difference between a plain outfit and a perfect outfit.
- Look for items that fit your personality and style! Don't purchase items that aren't you because you think that what's you should buy. Make sure every purchase is something you love.
- **Try things on!** Be sure to try everything on before you purchase and make sure they fit you correctly, you can move in them comfortably and the length is right.
